THIS WEEK: Waynesburg will travel to face Dickinson in the ECAC Southeast Bowl this weekend for the first-ever meeting between the two schools. The Yellow Jackets cruised to a 54-13 win over Westminster last weekend, while the Red Devils defeated Ursinus, 35-20.



HELLER SETS MARK IN 54-13 WIN:

Freshman running back **Robert Heller** helped Waynesburg close its regular season in dominating fashion, defeating Westminster, 54-13. Heller became the first player in school history to rush for 2,000 yards in a season with his single-game school record 312 yards and five touchdowns on 40 attempts against the Titans. Senior defensive end **Mike Czerwien** anchored the defense with eight tackles (seven solo), 4.0 tackles for loss (TFL) and three sacks.

GAME NOTES

DICKINSON HEAD COACH DARWIN BREAUX: In his 15th year as head coach of the Red Devils, **Darwin Breaux** is the winningest coach in Dickinson history. In his first season as head coach, he guided the team to an ECAC Southwest Bowl before taking coaching the team to a 10-0 regular season in 1994 with an NCAA Playoff appearance. Breaux is a 1977 graduate of West Chester University, where he was a four-year member of the football team.

DICKINSON PROFILE: Dickinson College is located in eastern Pennsylvania in Carlisle, about 30 minutes southwest of Harrisburg. The trip from Waynesburg to Carlisle is approximately three-and-a-half hours. The Red Devils feature 21 varsity sports with several sports using Biddle Field, including football, men's lacrosse, women's field hockey and track & field.

SCOUTING DICKINSON: Dickinson enters this weekend's game with an 8-2 record after winning the final two games of the season. The Red Devils feature the second-ranked rushing defense in the Centennial Conference (CC) behind the play of senior linebacker **Eric Dube**, who is the first player in the conference's 25-year history to earn back-to-back Defensive Player of the Year honors. Dickinson features one of the league's top offensive players in senior **Chris McInerney**, who led the CC with 154.9 all-purpose yards/game. McInerney finished the regular season with 699 receiving yards on 68 receptions and served as the top return threat for the Red Devils.

WAYNESBURG VS. THE CENTENNIAL: The Yellow Jackets hold a 5-8 all-time record against the nine current members of the Centennial Conference (CC). Waynesburg last played a member of the CC in 2004 when it lost to Johns Hopkins, 26-23, in the ECAC Southeast Bowl in Baltimore, Md.

YELLOW JACKETS IN POST-SEASON: Waynesburg returns to the post-season this weekend for the third time in five years. However, the Yellow Jackets have lost their last two post-season games by a combined seven points after winning their first two post-season games in school history en route to the NAIA National Championship in 1966.

EIGHT IS GREAT: With a 54-13 win over Westminster last weekend, the Yellow Jackets earned their eighth victory this year, marking the third eight-win season in school history. Waynesburg also won at least eight games in 1932 (8-1), 1966 (11-0), 1967 (8-1) and 2003 (9-2). The Yellow Jackets started the season with seven-straight victories for the first time since the 1967 season. With the seven-consecutive wins to start the season, plus two wins at the end of last season, Waynesburg boasted its second-longest winning streak in school history at nine before losing to unbeaten Washington & Jefferson.

TOP OF THE LIST: With his school record 22.0 sacks (21 solo, two assists) this season, senior defensive end **Mike Czerwien** now holds the NCAA all-division record for career sacks with 52.5. The four-year starter broke the previous record of 49.0 career sacks by Steven Wilson of King's (Pa.) (2000-02) earlier this season. Czerwien is just 2.0 sacks shy of tying the NCAA all-division single-season sack record of 24.0 sacks held by both Division III's Russ Watson of Worcester State in 2000 and Football Bowl Subdivision's (FBS, formerly Division I-A) Terrell Suggs of Arizona State in 2002 .

ANOTHER RECORD IN SIGHT: Freshman running back **Robert Heller** has made an impact on the NCAA record books this season. The Ringgold graduate shattered the Division III record for most rushing yards in a season by a freshman with 2,019 yards, eclipsing the previous record of 1,380 yards by Fredrick Nanhed of Cal Lutheran in 1995. Heller has also surpassed the FBS and Football Championship Season (FCS, formerly Division I-AA) mark for rushing yards by a freshmen held by Adrian Peterson of Oklahoma (1,925 yards in 2004) and Adrian Peterson of Georgia Southern (1,932 yards in 1998). The NCAA all-division record for most rushing yards by a freshman is 2,065 yards set last season by Joique Bell of Wayne State (Mich.), a Division II program.

ADD IT TO THE LIST: Waynesburg senior defensive end **Mike Czerwien** earned Presidents' Athletic Conference (PAC) Defensive Player of the Week honors on Monday following his performance against Westminster. The four-year starter posted eight tackles (seven solo) with 4.0 TFL and three sacks. It marks the second time this season and third time in his career that Czerwien received the weekly conference award. The Pittsburgh native also has been tabbed to the D3football.com Team of the Week four times this season.

UNDER 21 CLUB: By holding Westminster to 13 points, Waynesburg has now held five opponents, all conference foes, to 21 points or less. The Yellow Jackets boast a perfect 5-0 record in those contests. The Waynesburg defensive unit also held Washington & Jefferson to a season-low 22 points, over two touchdowns under its season average, and allowed only 17 points to Geneva in regulation before falling in overtime.

ONE OF THE BEST: The Yellow Jackets continue to make their climb up the national statistical rankings, as Waynesburg is ranked among the top 25 in the nation in five defensive categories. The Yellow Jackets are No. 4 in the nation in total defense (218.1 yards/game), No. 5 in rushing defense (60.0 yards/game), No. 5 in sacks (4.1 sacks/game), No. 17 in TFL (9.3 TFL/game) and No. 21 in pass efficiency (93.5 rating). The Waynesburg defense also ranks among the national leaders with 18 interceptions.

EXTENDING THE STREAK: Waynesburg defensive end **Mike Czerwien** broke the school record for consecutive career starts with his 42nd-straight start last weekend against Westminster. He was previously tied with former offensive lineman **Andy Palko** (2001-2004) for the record with 41. Palko was a three-time all-conference guard for the Yellow Jackets and started two post-season games.

THE 2K MAN: Waynesburg freshman **Robert Heller** became the first player in school history to rush for 2,000 yards in a season last weekend when he broke his own single-game school rushing record with 312 yards. He is the 11th different player in Division III history to amass 2,000 rushing yards in a season and enters this weekend ranked eighth in single-season NCAA Division III record book with 201.9 rushing yards/game.

A VETERAN UNIT: The Waynesburg offensive line is one of the most experienced in the region. The Yellow Jackets have typically started two seniors (**Alex Tempalski** and **Dan Vitale**), a junior (**Max Anderson**) and two sophomores (**Jared Bussard** and **Adam Pastrnak**) on the line this season. Tempalski (right guard) leads all Waynesburg offensive players with 32 career starts, while Vitale has started 19 games at center in his career. Bussard (right tackle) and Pastrnak (left guard) have each started 18 games each, while Anderson (left tackle) has started a combined 12 games in the last two seasons. The offensive line quintet has combined for 99 career starts, while the two-deep combined for 110 career starts among the group.

CLIMBING THE CHART: With his single-game school record 312 yards against Westminster, Waynesburg running back **Robert Heller** increased his career rushing total to 2,019 yards, which ranks eighth in school history. He passed both **Troy Westenbarger** (1989-92) and **Otto Birkhead** (1981-83) on the all-time rushing list last weekend.

SHARING THE WEALTH: Through the 10-game regular season, 11 different Yellow Jackets have found their way into the end zone. Freshman running back **Robert Heller** headlines the group after leading Division III with 27 total touchdowns (26 rushing). Also scoring touchdowns on the ground this season for Waynesburg are senior fullback **Aaron Davis** (6), senior running back **Jamelle Price** (3) and freshman running back **J.J. Johnson**. Freshman wide receiver **Ray Hightower II** leads the team with three receiving touchdowns, while senior tight end **Ryan Cronin** (2) and junior **Andy Hodanich** (1) have also pulled down touchdowns through the air. Other touchdowns have come from sophomore safety **Ryan Krull** (interception return), sophomore returner **Scott Cree** (punt return) and senior cornerback **Jacques Newberry** (interception return).

EARNING A START: Waynesburg has had 14 players record their first career start in 2007, including two that have started all 10 games in redshirt sophomore safety **Ryan Krull** and freshman running back **Robert Heller**. Junior **Andy Lauterbach** and freshman **Kyle Kyper** have combined to start all 10 games this season at quarterback with each making their first career starts this season. The Yellow Jackets have also featured a combined three first-time starters at tight end this season, while also starting freshmen **Ray Hightower II** and **Kory Jackson** at the wide receiver positions. Waynesburg has used three different players at an outside linebacker position, while sophomores **Dylan August** and **Scott Cree** have earned starts in the secondary.

LAST TIME OUT

HELLER RUSHES FOR 312 YARDS, ECLIPSES 2,000 YARDS IN 54-13 WIN OVER WESTMINSTER

WAYNESBURG (Nov. 10) – Freshman running back **Robert Heller** helped Waynesburg University close its regular season in dominating fashion on Saturday afternoon, as it defeated Westminster College, 54-13, in Presidents' Athletic Conference (PAC) action at John F. Wiley Stadium on Senior Day. Against the Titans, Heller became the first player in school history to rush for 2,000 yards in a season after he totaled a single-game school record 312 yards and five touchdowns (11, 2, 21, 3, 2) on 40 attempts.

Heller, the nation's leading rusher and scorer, surpassed his own previous single-game rushing record with his 312 yards, while the five rushing touchdowns ties his single-game and school record. The Ringgold product is the first player in school history to rush for 300 yards in a game and already ranks eighth all-time in career rushing at Waynesburg with 2,019 yards in 10 games.

Behind the 300-yard performance by Heller, Waynesburg amassed 370 team rushing yards on 58 attempts (6.4 yards/attempt) for the fourth highest single-game total in school history.

With the score tied at 7-7 midway through the first quarter, the Yellow Jackets scored 21 unanswered points on two Heller touchdowns (2, 21) and a 5-yard touchdown plunge by senior fullback **Aaron Davis** to make the score 28-7 with 13:58 left before halftime. The Titans added a fourth-down touchdown in the second quarter to cut the deficit to 28-13 (kick blocked).

Waynesburg scored touchdowns on each of its first two possessions in the second half with a 2-yard score by Heller and a 37-yard touchdown pass from junior quarterback **Andy Lauterbach** to freshman wide receiver **Ray Hightower II** to increase the lead to 48-13 with 00:03 seconds left in the third quarter.

Lauterbach completed 9-of-15 attempts for 167 yards with a touchdown and no interceptions. Hightower II led the Yellow Jackets in receiving with 115 yards on five receptions and a touchdown.

The Waynesburg defense limited the Titans to only 35 rushing yards on 29 attempts and 188 yards of total offense – almost 150 yards below their season average.

Senior linebacker **Brendon Steele** led the Yellow Jackets with 11 tackles (six solo) and a forced fumble, while sophomore safety **Ryan Krull** added nine stops (four solo). Senior defensive end **Mike Czerwien** finished with eight tackles (seven solo), 4.0 TFL, three sacks and a quarterback hurry. Senior safety **Stefon Strothers** also added eight stops (five solo) with 2.0 TFL and a sack.

WAYNESBURG IN THE POST-SEASON

Nov. 26, 1966 - NAIA Semifinal Game - Albuquerque, N.M. Waynesburg 30, New Mexico Highlands 27

The Yellow Jackets escaped New Mexico Stadium in thrilling fashion, defeating New Mexico Highlands in the final seconds of the game, 30-27, with a 5-yard halfback pass from All-American running back **Rich Dahar** to **Bob Miltenberger** with 14 seconds remaining. The Cowboys jumped out to a 20-0 lead before the Yellow Jackets scored 16 unanswered points in the third quarter to take a 23-20 lead. Waynesburg used a 4-yard run from fullback **Rich Ripepi**, a 21-yard field goal by **Ben Falcone** and another Dahar touchdown pass to take the lead. However, Highlands retook the lead, 27-23, with a 5-yard touchdown by Grady Herold and 1:09 left in the game. On the eventual game-winning drive, quarterback **Don Paull** completed three passes including two to Dan Dvorchak before Dahar threw the game-winning touchdown pass on third down.

Dec. 10, 1966 - NAIA National Championship Game - Tulsa, Okla. Waynesburg 42, Wisconsin-Whitewater 21

Behind the play of All-American running back **Rich Dahar** and a stellar defensive effort, the Yellow Jackets captured the 1966 NAIA National Championship with a 42-21 victory over Wisconsin-Whitewater, 42-21. The game was played at Skelly Stadium at the University of Tulsa on a 24-degree day. Dahar finished the game with then-bowl records of 233 yards and three rushing touchdowns on 41 attempts, while the Waynesburg defense limited the Hawks to negative-39 rushing yards. Whitewater cut the deficit to 26-21 before Waynesburg scored the final 16 points of the game on two touchdowns by Dahar and a safety by **Joe Hornak**. Dahar also threw a halfback option pass for a touchdown to **Dan Dvorchak** in the second quarter. Waynesburg finished the game with 417 yards of total offense and 22 first downs on 87 offensive plays.

Nov. 22, 2003 - NCAA Division III Playoffs - Bridgewater, Va. Bridgewater 28, Waynesburg 24

Riding a seven-game win streak and ranked in the nation for the first time in school history, the Yellow Jackets lost their first-ever NCAA playoff game, 28-24, at No. 8 Bridgewater. The Eagles rallied from a 17-0 halftime deficit to take a 21-17 lead with 12:29 left in the game. Both teams traded touchdowns in the fourth before a fourth-down pass from junior quarterback **Jeff Dumm** was tipped away to end the Yellow Jackets' most successful season since the NAIA National Championship team of 1966. Dumm completed 21-of-47 attempts for 295 yards with an interception and two touchdowns, both to junior wide receiver **Paul D'Imperio**. D'Imperio finished the game with 153 yards on 10 receptions with two first-half scores. Freshman running back **Eric Daniels** rushed for 150 yards and a touchdown on 22 carries.

Nov. 20, 2004 - ECAC Southeast Bowl - Baltimore, Md. Johns Hopkins 26, Waynesburg 23

Despite posting a 21-17 halftime lead, Waynesburg lost its second-straight post-season game. The Blue Jays took their first lead of the game, 23-21, with 11:55 remaining in the fourth after an 8-yard score. On the ensuing PAT try, junior safety **Andy Tenney** picked up the loose ball and returned it the entire length of the field to tie the score at 23-23. Hopkins took back the momentum on its next possession with a 10-play, 71-yard scoring drive. Waynesburg was unable to manage a last-minute, game-winning drive, as a Hail Mary attempt fell short of the end zone. Senior quarterback **Jeff Dumm** completed 27-of-42 attempts for 263 yards with two touchdowns and no interceptions. Senior wide receiver **Paul D'Imperio** finished with 11 receptions for 110 yards and a touchdown, while sophomore running back **Eric Daniels** posted 126 rushing yards on 30 attempts.
